

A QUICK COMPLIANCE CHECK

Here is a quick check for compliance issues within the workplace. Consider whether not only are permits and licenses in place, but also, are they accurate and do they reflect true plant operations as specified within the permits or licenses. Here are a few selected checklist questions to assist.

- Do recent modifications to plant and equipment materially influence permit conditions in such a manner that they might have an added health, safety or environmental implication? (e.g. boiler capacity, chemicals throughput, storage capacities. etc.)
- Have any changes or modifications changed the risk profile of the operations? (Increased stockholdings of hazardous chemicals or fuels, increased plant capacity, more employees exposed to hazardous working conditions, etc.)
- Has there been any change in water, energy or raw material consumption which may have to be changed in permit or license conditions?
- Has any NEW process or operation been added which might have a cumulative environmental impact?
- Have any new operations or processes been introduced which require permitting in terms of water, air or planning legislation? (Local by-laws,

provincial ordinances, national laws and regulations)

- Have you checked to make sure that you are complying with all the legislation that is applicable to your particular operations? (Air, water, planning, by-laws, ordinances, laws and regulations, EMPs, EIAs, WUL Audits, conditions audits, etc.)
